If you can help, please bring these items, all packed in a 5-gallon bucket (preferably with lid), to the church ASAP. Please add a card or note expressing your concern and prayers for them. These supplies help people begin the overwhelming cleanup job after a flood or storm. We have Bibles to add to each bucket:

Flood Bucket

5-gallon plastic bucket (with re-sealable lid, if available)

Bleach--two 1-quart or one 82 oz. bottle

Scouring pads

6-8 sponges

1 scrub brush

15-18 cleaning towels (reusable wipes, like "Handi-Wipes")

Liquid laundry detergent (two 25 oz. or one 50 oz. bottle)

1 household cleaner, 12-16 oz. bottle

Disinfectant dish soap, 16-28 oz. bottle

180 count box "wet" (baby) wipes

50 clothes pins

Clothes line (two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.)

5 dust masks

2 pair latex gloves

1 pair work gloves

24-bag roll of heavy-duty trash bags, 33-45 gallon (remove roll from box before placing in bucket)

1 Insect repellant spray, 6-14 oz. (If aerosol, cans must have protective caps)

1 Air freshener, 8 or 9 oz. (If aerosol, cans must have protective caps.)

Health Kit for Men

- 1 hand towel (15" x 25" up to 17" x 27", No kitchen towels)
- 1 washcloth
- 1 comb (large and sturdy, not pocket-sized)

fingernail clippers

- 1 bath-size bar of soap (3 oz. and up)
- 1 toothbrush (single brushes only in original wrapper, No child-size brushes)
- 1 large tube of toothpaste
- 1 box of bandaides
- 1 miniature shaving crème

small pack of disposable razors

stick of deoderant

Place these items inside a sealed one-gallon plastic bag.

Health Kit for Women

1 hand towel (15" x 25" up to 17" x 27", No kitchen towels)

1 washcloth

hair brush

nail file or emery board

Q-tips

Tweezers

1 bath-size bar of soap (3 oz. and up)

1 toothbrush

1 large tube of toothpaste

1 box of bandaides

1 miniature shaving crème small pack of disposable razors

deoderant

clear nail polish

sanitary hand cream
